Wings of Hope deeply appreciates the generous gift [REDACTED] from Paule, Camazine, and Blumenthal staff toward our efforts in Haiti. We are grateful to the employees of the firm for the funds raised on your jeans casual day.


Wings of Hope has operated in Haiti for six years. Our nine volunteers partner with various other Humanitarian charities to routinely serve the poor with health care, educational efforts and orphanages.

Because we have been in-country for so long, we were able to begin relief work within hours after the quake hit; and our two twin-engine aircraft began arriving every four hours from our Bases in Puerto Rico and the Dominican Republic. Medical supplies were immediately transported, along with water, high protein and high fat survival food. Later, we transported body bags, cadaver dogs and more sophisticated medical equipment. To date, we have shipped 157 tons of supplies and flown 172 patients.

Wings of Hope will remain long after the US military and the other NGOs leave. Our presence in Haiti, like all of our Bases of Operations, is deliberate, holistic and intended to help the poor ultimately become self-sufficient.

It is the kindness and generosity of our members, donors and dedicated volunteers that our work is possible. The staff of PCB are the reason that life-saving Humanitarian efforts are provided **daily** to those who otherwise would fall by the wayside. Enclosed is a form letter which can be copied and completed for PCB's 48 participants in the jeans casual day.
